Enniskillen

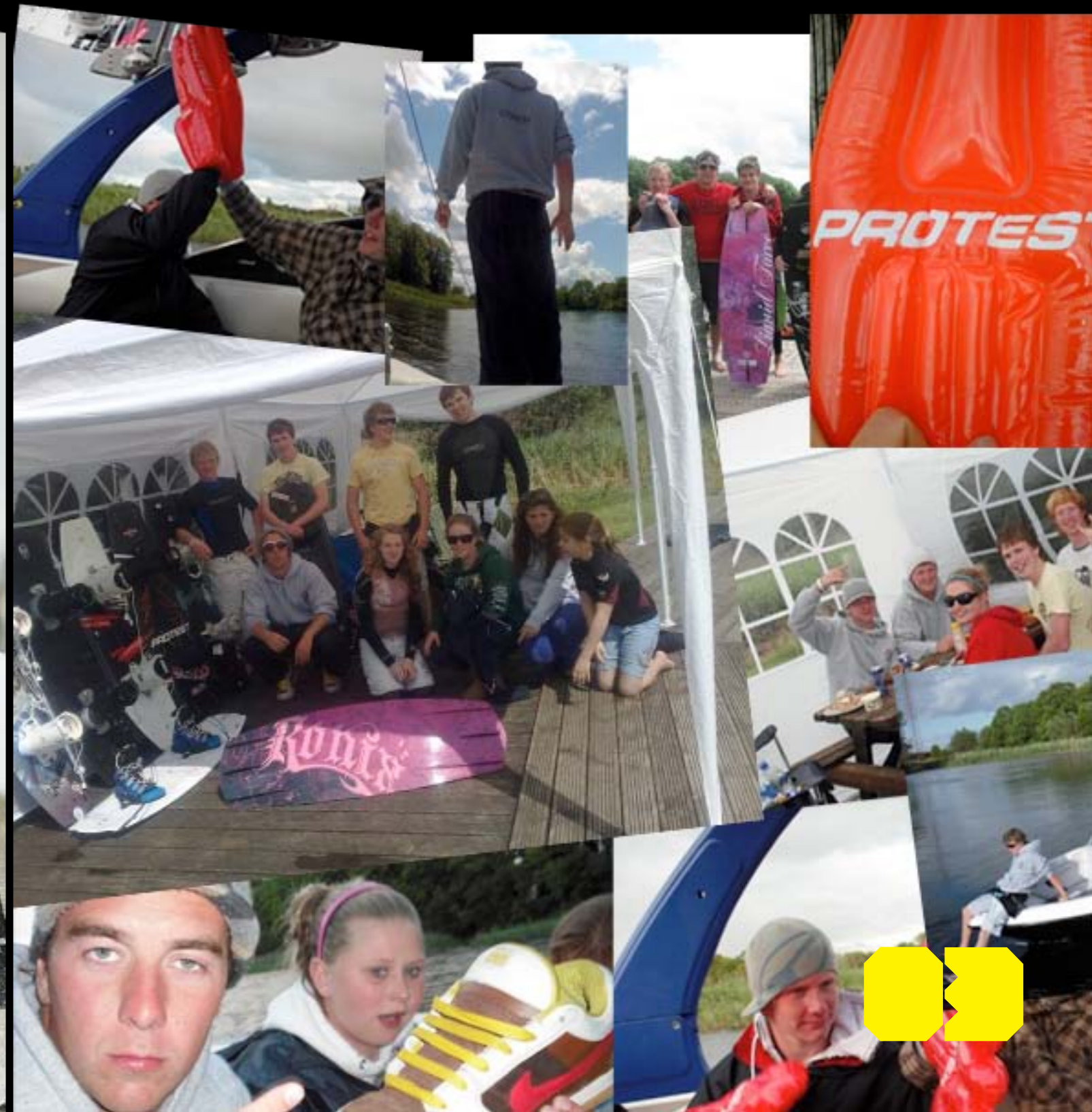

Spain

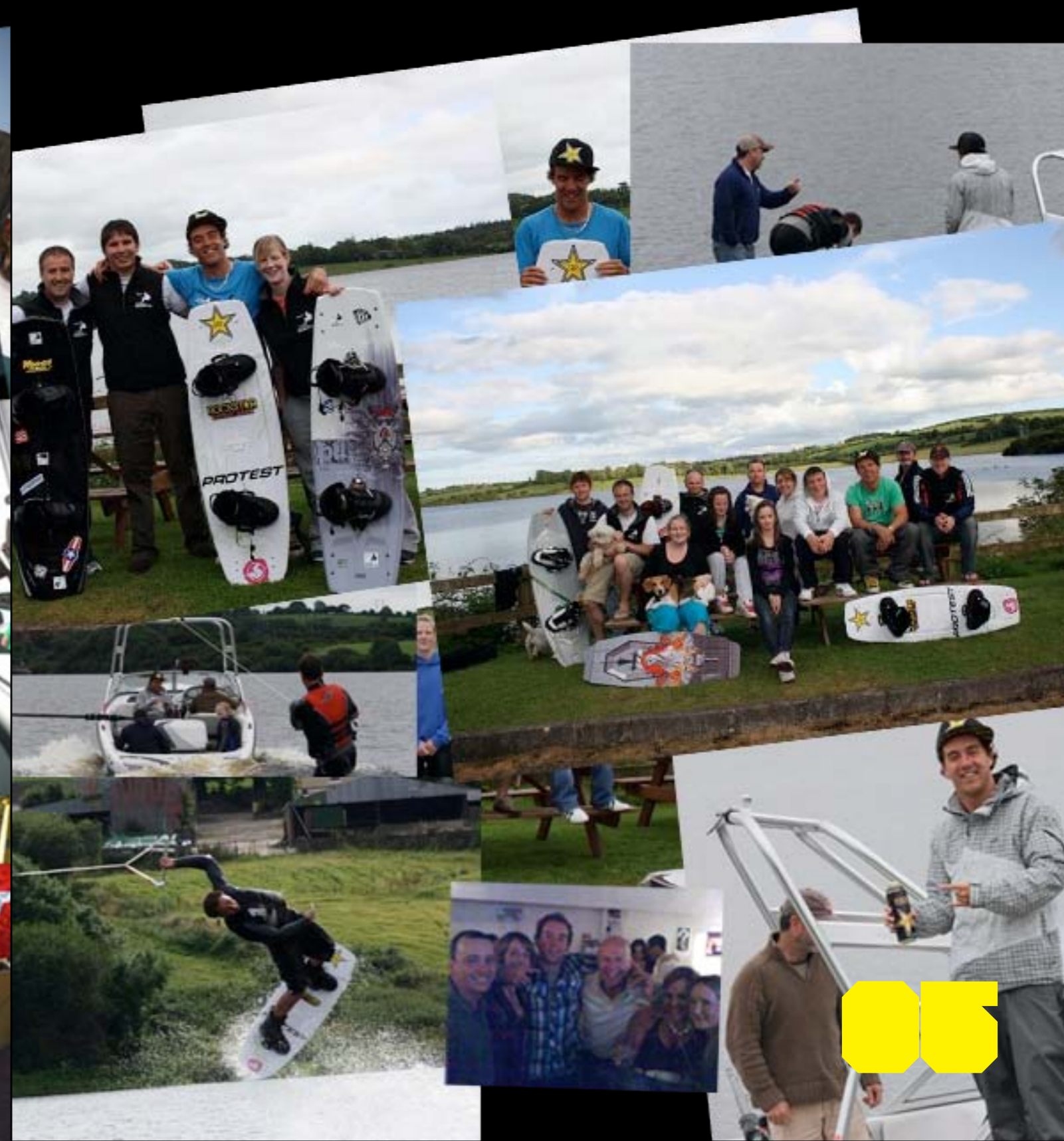

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS SO FAR

In 2002/2003 I wakeboarded for GBR as a team rider. In 2003 at the WWA World Championships in Orlando, Florida, Having trained since July for this event I achieved third place in the Men's 1 finals resulting in being ranked the WWA Men's 1 world number 3.

In 2008 I became Irish team captain and represented them at the EAME championships in Tremolat France. I finished 6th in the Open Mens division and the Irish team finished 2nd overall the first time a team from Ireland has ever reached the podium.

Also in 2008 I finished 1st in the Open Mens division in Wakejam, a European wakeboarding contest organised in Enniskillen Ireland.

Quote from Pro rider Glenn Fletcher last year:

"In my opinion Peter Stewart has the riding prowess and wakeboarding experience that only a few pro wakeboarders achieve in their careers. Years spent training in Florida and competing world wide have given him the knowledge and patience that few riders have.
